Note: "a quarter dose, half a hit" or "Tripping a little bit" is not microdosing! This might be termed "mini-dosing". Actual microdosing is a very small amount, 1/10 or even less of a full dose, with effects that should not be at all "trippy".

Decriminalization:

Chicago Resolution: *Expression of support for adult use of Entheogenic Plants and call for hearing(s) to discuss findings from Department of Public Health on feasibility of use of Entheogenic Plants and its plant compounds as alternative treatment options*
Committee on Health and Human Relations

Note: This did not actually decriminalize anything, but is simply a “call for hearings”. However, with a 50-0 approval vote and 5 pages of references, it's a significant step forward. Worthwhile reading— lots of compelling *Whereases*. This is being used as a model for Arizona and other locations.
